Dear Parent/Carer

As we embark on 2024, I'd like to take the opportunity to highlight the evolution and development of our Hub Advisory Board roles. As you may be aware, in January 2023 our revised model of local governance was launched, whereby local governing boards were replaced with Hub Advisory Boards (HABs). Each HAB represents between 6-8 schools across primary and secondary phase and has the opportunity to feed the voice of the community directly to the Chair of Trustees and CEO. Although initially purely advisory, the role of the HAB has now evolved to ensure a greater input for community voice on key issues that impact students, such as attendance, behaviour, and SEND. Each HAB meets on a formal basis three times a year. HAB members are also involved in key strategic visits throughout the year, supporting and triangulating the work of the school improvement team.


